Watercolour Evening Seascape with Clouds and Reflections

Wednesday 25 May & 1 June 2022

In this Set of Two Classes:

You will create a landscape in watercolour, learning techniques for creating clouds and reflections in water.

In the first class (25 May) you will lay down the composition and foundation colours, and in the class on 1 June you will work the techniques for details and colours.

Equipment for This Class

- Watercolour Paper (cold press) rough or medium texture/grain; 300 gsm);
- HB Pencil & eraser
- Large flat or "mop" watercolour brush and smaller watercolour brushes
- Large, medium and small round watercolour brushes
- Watercolour paints (either pan or tube); Colours recommended include:
 - Cobalt Blue; French Ultramarine; Alizarin Crimson; Burnt Sienna; Burnt Umber; Turner's Yellow; Quinacridone Gold; Indigo or Payne's Grey
- Palette/dinner plate for mixing colours
- Board with painters' tape/masking tape for taping down paper to prevent buckling
