

Masculine and Feminine in Spanish



Key Information

Nouns are words that name people, places, things and ideas. In Spanish, all nouns are either **masculine** or **feminine**.

masculine

Masculine nouns have **el** (the) or **un** (a/an) in front of them.

feminine

Feminine nouns have **la** (the) or **una** (a/an) in front of them.

As a general rule we could say that words that end with **-o** are **masculine** and words that end with **-a** are **feminine**.


But not always!

E.g.

el gorila/
un gorila



la mano/
una mano



E.g.

el perro/
un perro



la cama/
una cama



Words that end with **-e** or **consonant** can be either **masculine** or **feminine**.

E.g.

el tomate/
un tomate



la llave/
una llave



el tractor/
un tractor



la sartén/
una sartén




