

# Singular and Plural in Spanish



## Key information



Nouns are words that name people, places, things and ideas.  
To make a noun plural in Spanish you need to do two things.

First, remember to make the determiners plural too:

el (the)

los (the)

un (a/an)

unos (some)

la (the)

las (the)


una (a/an)

unas (some)

Second, change the noun to plural by:

Adding an **-s** if the singular noun ends with a **vowel**. E.g.

	<b>la botella</b>	→	<b>las botellas</b>		<b>una botella</b>	→	<b>unas botellas</b>
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Adding **-es** if the singular noun ends with a **consonant**. E.g.

	<b>el ordenador</b>	→	<b>los ordenadores</b>		<b>un ordenador</b>	→	<b>unos ordenadores</b>
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Adding **-ces** if the singular noun ends with **-z**. Careful! You need to remove **-z** first. E.g.

	<b>el lápiz</b>	→	<b>los lápices</b>		<b>un lápiz</b>	→	<b>unos lápices</b>
