Chinese Calligraphy

Materials. Pencil ,paper, ruler and eraser.

(Keep paper ,scissors, masking tape, an old sponge, an old tray handy.)

Brushes size 2, 6, 12

Black Ink....or black watercolour

Suitable for attendees wishing to improve their ‘Focus’ in art and demonstrate cognitive processing and development in their artwork. It is most suitable for those attendees who require exercises for fine motor skills. Each lesson is of 60 minutes duration.

LESSON

During these classes we focus on Chinese Calligraphy as our motif to explore Chinese symbols and the calligraphic process employed to produce them.

The early Chinese written words were simplified pictorial images, indicating meaning through suggestion or imagination. These simple images were flexible in composition, capable of developing with changing conditions by means of slight variations.

During these classes we will explore brushwork and repeat the symbols presented to form a collection of linked themes.

The theme explored will be the 5 elements.
