In this Class:

You will learn to vary line weight in either ink or pencil, and the importance of line weight in creating movement and dynamism in an artwork. The inspiration for this lesson will be an ink drawing, "Mother and Child", by the famous Japanese artist Katsushika Hokusai.

Note: Don't worry about copying this reference picture perfectly; the purpose of this class is to practice drawing folds of cloth and other lines with varying weight rather than drawing a perfect imitation of this study.
